Many consider the Grand Canyon – one of the Seven Wonders of the World - to be the most awesome sight on earth. It is truly nature's history book, dating back over two billion years. During this tour, you will explore the beauty of the Canyon from many scenic overlooks, each vibrant with the earth's colors. Your guide will tell tales of the Canyon's earliest settlers and explorers, and will provide you with information on its cultural history, geology and biology.

You will have time on your own for shopping, visiting the museums of the Hopi Indians (and their prehistoric ancestors, the Anasazi), or taking the many self-guided walking tours along the rim of the Canyon. You may also want to attend a multimedia slide program depicting the Canyon's history, geology, and beauty.

We will make a stop at a Trading Post located on a Navajo Indian Reservation. The Cameron Trading Post, one of the original historic Trading Posts is great for shopping for jewelry, gifts, rugs, paintings and hand-made pottery (don't miss the Indian Fry Bread) – all authentic and from the reservations surrounding the Canyon.

Be sure to join us for this incredible, day-long visit at the Grand Canyon!

SEDONA

Sedona, It's simply magical with its breathtaking scenery, sheer canyon walls, and incredible red rock formations.

Your first stop will be at Montezuma's castle— a well-preserved ancient Indian cliff dwelling that was abandoned by the Sinaqua Indian Tribe more that a thousand years ago. Then you'll take off for a variety of scenic drives that includes the gorgeous Oak Creek Canyon, often photographed with its layers of different colored stone deposits that date back to pre-historic times. You will also visit the renowned Cathedral in the Rocks.

Spend time at Tlaquepaque, a recreated Mexican Market Village with colorful tiles, sparkling fountains, and over 50 unique, high-end shops that showcase the works and wares of the local artisans, as well as pottery and products from Mexico.

Some of the sights that may be included in this tour: the State Capitol, historic Heritage Square (with its original pioneer homes built back in 1895), and the Old Territorial Museum which has been restored to its original 1899 state. Arizona State University to see the theater designed by Frank Lloyd Wright and then take a driving tour past the mansion homes of Phoenix. Later, you'll bask in the elegance of a bygone era as you visit the incredible, historic Biltmore Hotel. Of course, time will be allotted for strolling, shopping and afternoon tea (on your own) at Biltmore Fashion Park. Spectacular blooming flowers and shrubs surround the elite stores that line the garden walkways.

You will pass through Paradise Valley view of the multi-million dollar homes, a great view of Camelback Mountain. Shopping for the riches of the Southwest will not be overlooked with a stop in Old Scottsdale

EARLY AMERICAN & ANTIQUE CAPITAL OF ARIZONA

Friday, July 24

Cost: \$54.50 – Includes guided tour and admissions. Lunch on your own at one of the historic homes. Complimentary bottled water included.

Stroll down a Victorian street, the scent of flowers wafting across the square, the clippety-clop sounds of a fringed, horse drawn buggy mingling in. Take a walk through a turn-of-the-century village with its friendly gas lamps and shaded brick sidewalks. Browse over 70 antique shoppes housed in century old homes. See tidy homes surrounded by white picket fences. Dine in an old fashioned tea room or at one of the charming, antique - filled restaurants where you can relax in a casual, yet elegant, atmosphere. All of this and more will give you a unique flavor of the Victorian era. And the Bead Museum is a "must-visit" on this tour. It showcases varieties of beads from 10,000 B.C. to the *present*. There are only three such museums in the country!

THE SONORAN DESERT – Adventures in a Hummer!

Enjoy and explore the intense terrain and serene mountain views of the Sonoran desert aboard one of the greatest 4' x 4' vehicles around - the unstoppable Hummer! You will go places a normal off-road vehicle can't – old mining trails, canyons, up and around fantastic rock formations – the Hummer conquers the toughest terrain with ease. Along the way your guide will entertain you with stories of the Old West and introduce you to the most fascinating wildlife of the desert. This adventure is perfect for everyone!

THE WRIGHT DAY IN SCOTTSDALE – (Taliesin, West and Cosanti)

Thursday, July 23

12:30 p.m. – 5:30 p.m.

Cost: \$85.00 – Includes transportation, guide and admissions to Cosanti and Taliesin. Complimentary bottled water included.

Taliesin, West – Taliesin is a wonderful example of how buildings can fit in beautifully with the environment. Frank Lloyd Wright was the dominant American architect of the first half of the 20th century. In 1937, he initiated a bold experiment in the Sonoran Desert of Scottsdale. He built his winter home and architectural studio -Taliesin, West- on a windswept plain in the foothills of the McDowell Mountains. It is a prime example of Wright's mission: man living in harmony with nature. You'll visit Taliesin, West on this unique guided tour which also delves into the personal life and history of Frank Lloyd Wright (hint: there's intrigue involved!)

Cosanti – is the home and studio of internationally known architect Paolo Soleri, a student of Frank Lloyd Wright.

Often Soleri himself will come out and mingle with his visitors. During the tour, you will visit the outdoor foundry where bells are designed and fabricated, and explore a wind chime museum in which a collection of wonderful chimes (commissioned by charities such as the Ronald McDonald House) is displayed. Many of the wind bells and chimes are available for purchase.

Scottsdale – Your day will end with a historic tour of the town of Scottsdale, Time for shopping in Old Town – where you can purchase Western wear, Indian Jewelry, gifts, and souvenirs.
